- 1961: Founded as “HMSS” – a healthcare-focused management engineering Society
- 1987: Renamed “HIMSS” – Welcomed IT professionals
- 1995: Established HIMSS Foundation – scholarships
- 2001 - 2003: Created corporate memberships, introduced focus on EHRs, linked to developers & IT pros
- 2004: Created research effort – “HIMSS Analytics”
- 2005: Established a global presence
- 2006: Introduced focus on payment and business end of healthcare IT
- 2007: Introduced Affiliate and Organizational Memberships

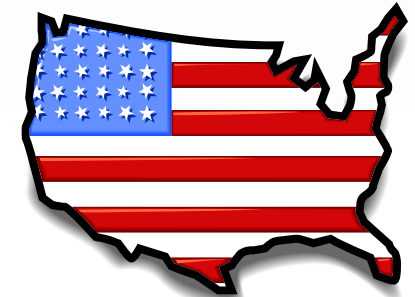

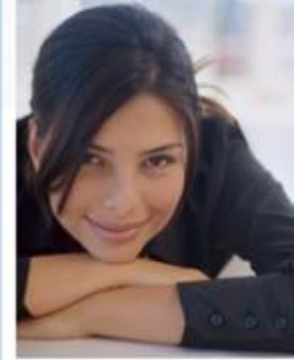
