Purpose

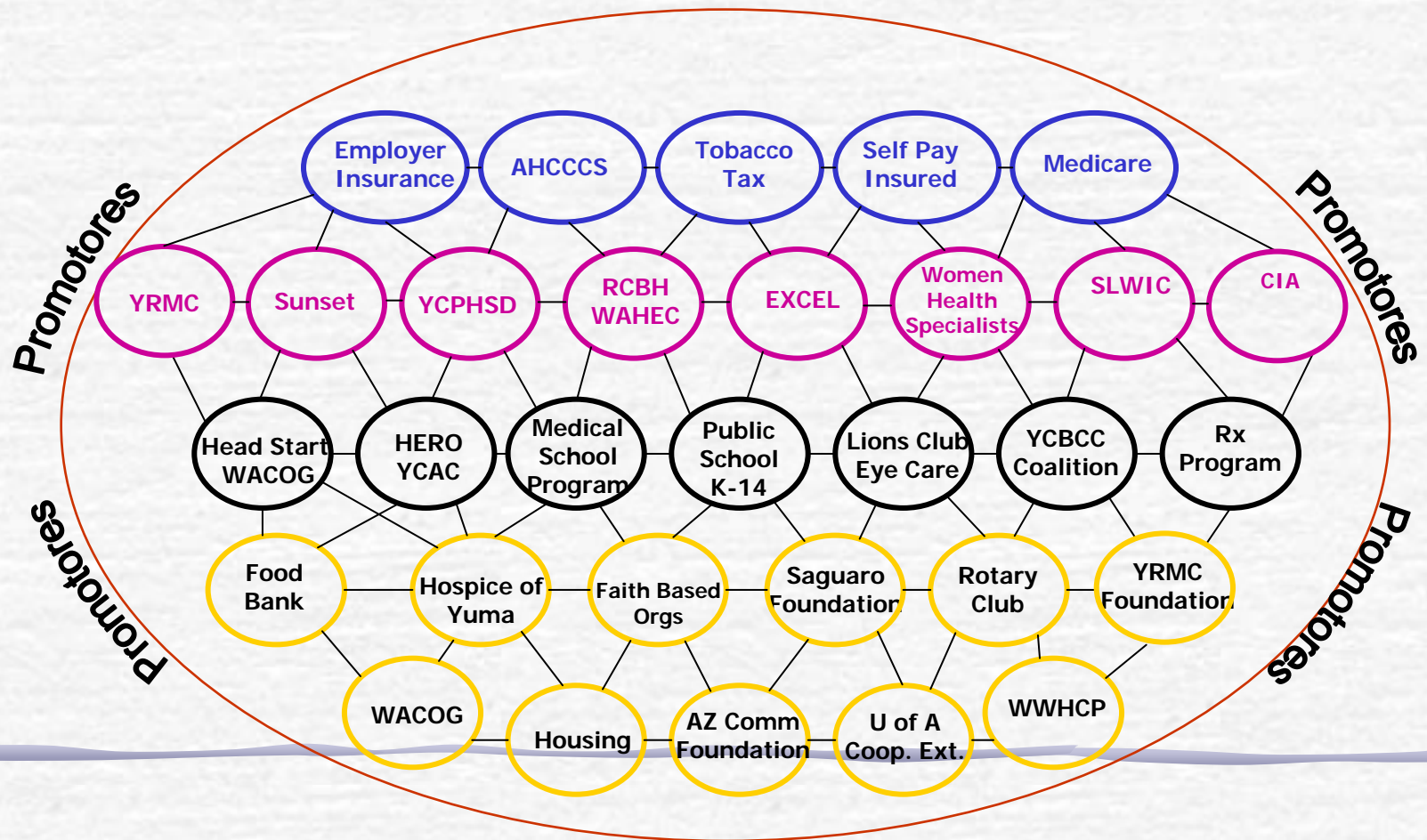
